NOTE FROM LAWSON – During his talk at St. Anne, Ken Ogorek mentioned the series, *The Chosen*. I'm always leery of anything Hollywoodish that depicts Jesus. He's always too wimpy, or weird or dazed. I held off jumping on the bandwagon for this one, but I'd like to whole-heartedly jump on and say, "WATCH IT! DO IT!"

The Chosen is a crazy experiment funded by regular people giving until enough is raised to film a season—about \$10,000,000. Wowie. They are working on their third season, there are two seasons already available in multiple languages and countries, The guy who plays Jesus is a Catholic, and a

collaborator with Word on Fire. Bishop Barron is a big fan! This show is beautiful, and rich, surprising and compelling, thoughtful and funny. It's full of Scripture, but is not a theological work. Is anyone old enough to remember the *You Are There* series? Lots of facts, but also lots of creative imagery that put you in the time and place of a historical event? That's what *The Chosen* does. It puts you in that distant time, in that foreign place, with these ridiculously normal human beings who try to follow Jesus in his divine humanity who they don't understand at all. Sound familiar? It is, and it is good, it is very, very good.

How do you watch it? Well, you're going to need your computer or a Roku tv or firestick or something that streams video. It's not on Netflix or Hulu, <u>but it is free!</u> You can watch from it's own website—google *The Angel Studios Network*, and it will come right up. If you have YouTube, *The Chosen* is available there. Or you can get *The Chosen* app from iTunes or Google and watch that way.

Don't expect this series to get everything exactly the way you have it in your head, it's not written by God! But it has a lot of support from all of Christendom, and it is just plain perfect for bingeing. Look and see, and I bet you jump on the bandwagon. Let me know!
